Preparation before examination

- ❖ Please bring your previous films and report for reference.
- ❖ It is convenient for you to bring together with the urine and stool specimen on the examination day.
- ❖ Please call our Centre for enquiries on other special investigations.

All Imaging Examinations

- ❖ Please inform our staff with confirmed / suspected Pregnancy.
- ❖ Please bring your previous films and report for reference.
- ❖ Please call our centre for enquiries on other special investigations.

PET– CT

- ❖ Please avoid any alimentary tract contrast tests for ten days prior to examination.
- ❖ Please do not perform any heavy exercise and uplift heavy items one day prior to examination.
- ❖ Fasting for six hours prior to examination.
- ❖ Diabetic patient is requested to consult your family doctor if there is a need to stop the medication for diabetics. For those who are required for contrast injection, you are required to stop the medication of Metformin (glucophage) for forty - eight hours prior to examination.
- ❖ It is recommended that your blood glucose reading is at 7.5mmol/L or below to perform PET-CT.
- ❖ After the examination, it is suggested to avoid close contact with pregnant women, children with age 12 or below or elderly with 24 hours.
